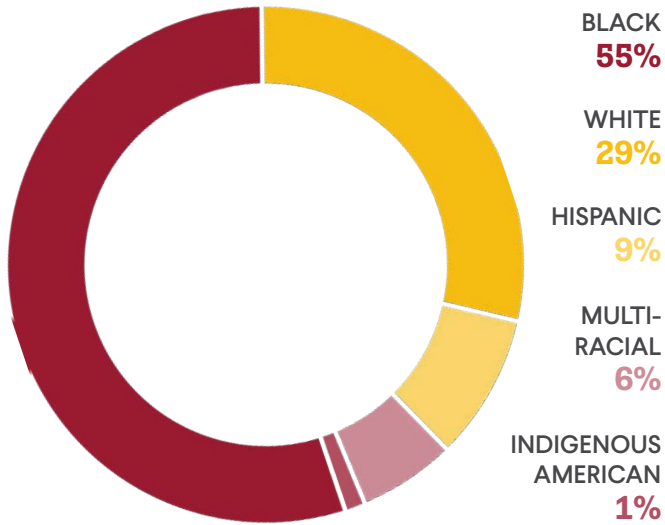

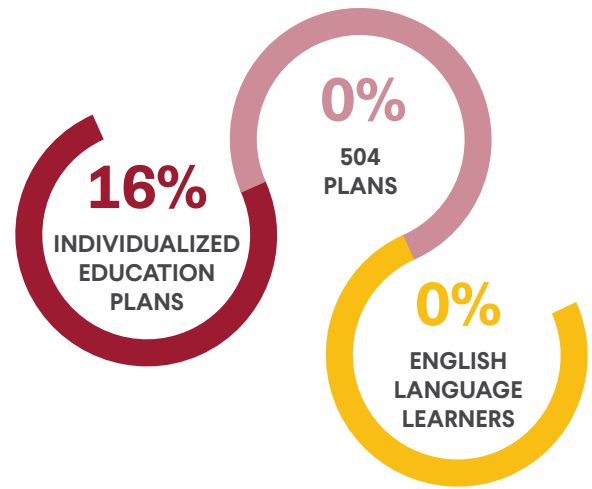

STUDENT DEMOGRAPHICS



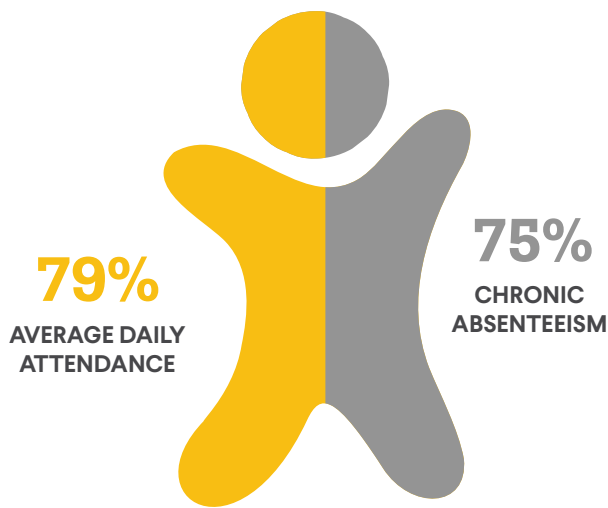

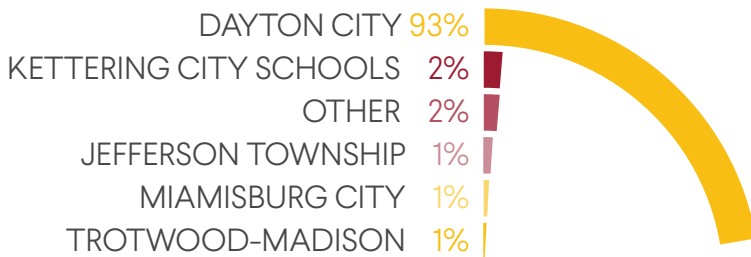

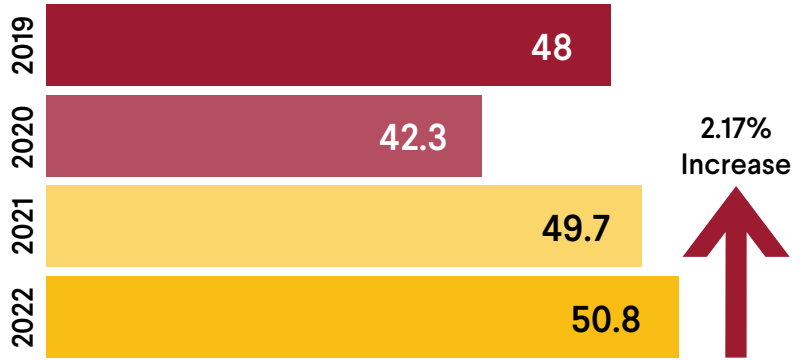

ACADEMIC PROGRESS

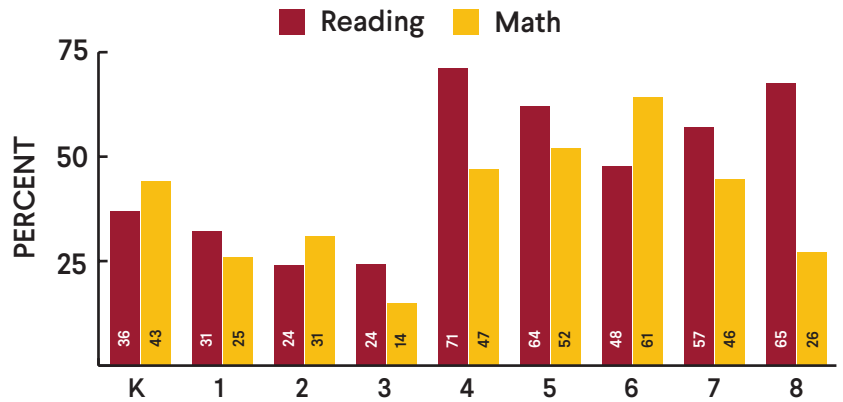
